First aid measures

Eye contact	Rinse the eyes immediately with water for at least 15 minutes. If discomfort persists, seek medical attention.

Storage	Keep away from high temperature, strong oxidising agents and ignition sources. Long-term storage should be in a suitably ventilated space.
